- ❑ Warm and dry conditions will persist through Thursday
- ❑ Afternoon thunderstorms will return to the forecast on Thursday however only a low chance (20-30%) will exist. Chances will increase through the weekend to around 80% with non severe general thunderstorms possible each afternoon area wide Friday through Tuesday.
- ❑ Temperatures will also slowly heat up through the weekend with many locations likely seeing temps near or just above 90 from Friday through Tuesday.
 - ❑ Heat indices will climb to the mid to high 90s Friday through Tuesday.
 - ❑ These will be some of the hottest temperatures of the summer so far and will prompt a Moderate Heat Risk for those outside.
